Help us avoid these issues:

- dogs jumping, barking at or bodyblocking people and bikes
- conflicts between on-and off-leash dogs (and their owners!)
- dog waste (especially off-trail) a mess for the local ecology, and for the volunteers who work on the trail
- owners calling out to their unleashed dogs disturbs our neighbors with homes on/along the trail
- dogs getting into hazards like toxic mushrooms and poison oak

Know the facts:

- Montclair Railroad Trail is an on-leash City of Oakland space, OMC#6.04.080
- owners are legally and financially responsible for any incidents and injuries involving their dogs
- dogs must be kept on a 6 ft. or shorter leash at all times OMC#6.04.070
- the City is stepping up patrols. You can be cited for not keeping your dog on leash while on the trail
